





What to talk about

...if you have only five minutes?




The Challenge

- ...or Rust!




Types of Five-Minute Presentations

- **Elevator Pitch** - Sell an idea
 - Why a Zig rewrite is the only way.
- **Lightning Talk** - Rapidly share an idea or concept

- **Micro Learning Session** - Showcase a specific skill or piece of knowledge
 - How to brew the perfect cup of Joe.
- **Ignite Talk** - Inspire or provoke thought on a topic
 - Things I hate about Javascript




Effective Topics for Short Presentations

- A single, focused Idea → like coffee roasting, instead of coffee in general
 - A Personal anecdote or experience → a failed coffee roasting experiment
 - A provocative question or thought → Salt as the answer to bitter coffee?

 - Cultural Insights
 - Passion Projects
 - Myth Busting
 - Future Predictions
 - Unexpected Connections



Structure and Delivery Tips

- Start Strong
- Have a clear beginning, middle and end
- Speak clearly and Concisely
- Use Effective Body Language

- Practice content and timing
- Engage the Audience
- Show Confidence


